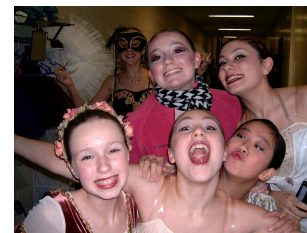

Join Lake Shore Dance Performance Company!

Minimum Requirements

Any dancer that wishes to participate in the Performance Company must dance in ballet (or a children's combination class) year round, including summer sessions. Company dancers in Level III and higher must also take jazz class. Students that dance a role on Pointe will also need to enroll in Pointe class year round.

Audition and Registration Information

There are several levels of company that determine placement and casting in the Nutcracker. While children may be placed in different company levels if the director sees fit, primarily students will be placed in the levels based on their regular class level that they will advance to in the fall.

Junior Apprentice: Pre-Ballet I—Beginning I

Apprentice: Beginning II-Advanced Beginning

Corps: Level III-IV

Secondary: Level V-VI

Soloist: Level VI, yr 2+

Principle: Placement only

To sign-up, please complete an application form, found at the front desk. Then, attend the audition. During the audition, the teachers will be watching the dancers to see how well the children work in groups, learn material, and demonstrate performance qualities. Please arrive 15 minutes early to the audition to prepare and check in.

Girls must be dressed in a black leotard, pink tights, and have their hair pulled back into a bun. Girls in Level V and higher may wear form fitted shorts or a ballet skirt. All girls must also have their ballet shoes. Girls auditioning for a Pointe role must also bring their Pointe shoes. Boys need to wear a white tank or t-shirt, black pants, and black ballet or jazz shoes.

We will post casting at the studio within one month of the audition.

Rehearsal and Commitment

Students will begin rehearsals in June during the summer session. The dancers will meet for one hour a week to learn a parade dance and prepare for summer performances.

Dancers that join company are a part of company for the entire season, which runs from June through December.

Dancers will be required to sell a minimum number of tickets to the Nutcracker performance and to promote the show within the community.

Cost and Fundraising

Tuition includes rehearsal times, rental of Nutcracker costumes (which are lent for performance only and must be returned after the show), and a free company T-shirt that will be worn in the parades.

Summer Rehearsal Tuition (due June 15): \$120.00

Fall Rehearsal Tuition (due September 15) :

\$139 Junior Apprentice \$165 Apprentice, Corps, Secondary, Soloist, Principle

*Families with more than one dancer in company may take a 5% family discount.

**Families who pay their company rehearsal summer and fall tuition in full by June 15 may deduct \$25.00 from their total company tuition.

There is no performance fee, audition fee or costume fee

To help you defray the costs of the Performance Company, we offer several fundraising opportunities in the summer. Please watch for postings and handouts regarding these opportunities.

Funds raised from fundraising events will be applied as credit only to the company account. Extra credits will not be paid out, but will roll over to be available for the next season.

Please note—you must be in the Performance Company to qualify for our traveling competition teams.

Typical Performance Schedule

Specific dates, times, and other performance details will be confirmed in the acceptance date.

Port Washington Street Festival, Strawberry Fest, Grafton Fourth of July Parade, Cedarburg 4th of July Parade, Port Washington Fish Days, Wine and Harvest Fest,

The Nutcracker will be in December and requires a day off of school to perform for school children.
