Additions to the Private lesson information brochure:

- All private lessons are to be pre-paid. You are registering for 44 Private lessons during the 2009-2010 season. Your monthly payment is figured as follows: Tuition for lesson multiplied by 44 (the number of lessons per year) divided by 12 months. Payment for private lessons in June will be due May 15th. If you will be missing a lesson, inform your instructor and she will schedule a make-up lesson with you. Extra lessons will be billed after they have been taken and will be payable with your next months private lesson payment. Late registrations will be subject to pro-ration, however we highly recommend that the student makes up the lessons that were missed. The instructor is not required to make-up lessons in excess of 5 per season. No credit or refund will be given for these lessons. If the instructor cancels more than 5 lessons in a session, the family may be issued a credit. This is the only situation that a credit may be given for missed lessons.
- If you add lessons during the year, an additional registration form must be filled out for the new lessons and received in the office prior to beginning the lessons.
- If your student or family receives credit for assisting or other work, you will receive a monthly statement with the amount of the credit. You may preserve the credit to minimize your final payment or subtract it monthly from your coupon amount.
- If you chose a choreography block, pay \$125.00 by June 1st and \$125.00 is due July 1st.
- All private lesson payments should be written out to Lake Shore Dance
